Questions:

- 3.) Some of us look like we are righteous because we stay where we are supposed to, but we have not yet repented. Why is it better to repent rather than maintain a false righteousness? What does this say about outward appearances in God's kingdom?
- 4.) Why does this person turn their home upside down to look for a simple coin? Who does this person stand for?
- 5.) How do you think it makes God feel when we run away? What does it mean to run from God?
- 6.) If God seeks us out this passionately, how are we supposed to react to Him?
